• The 2010 SDCCS committee would like to invite ALL Provincial Representatives as well as ALL dancers (Primary, Beginner, Novice, Intermediate, Restricted Premier & Premier) competing in the 2010 event to participate in the opening ceremonies. All dancers will represent their province or visiting country by walking in the parade.

WHAT SHOULD THE DANCERS WEAR?

- All dancers must wear their kilts, tartan hose or appropriate socks and dance shoes.
- Important: We ask that Provincial Representatives wear their rep jackets and all other dancers wear their dance school or dance association jacket with their kilts. In the case a dancer has neither type of jacket they are to wear their full kilt outfit.
- Dancers are also encouraged to bring hand-held provincial or national flags to be waved during the march.

• In order to participate, we ask that ALL dancers be at the dress rehearsal on Wednesday, July 7th from 4:00pm – 5:30pm at the Saskatoon Field House.
